Borshchiv, Ukraine. In June 2015 the Energy Farm International Foundation, received funding from the ministry of foreign affairs in Norway. The three year project started in July 2016 and the aim is to establish a knowledge-, meeting- and market place in Borshchiv after the Norwegian concept. Part of the project is study trip to Norway.

Preliminary program:

Monday March 14th. Visit to the Energy Farm to gain oversight over the use of bioenergy in Norway and get insight into the role the Energy Farm center has played in increased use of renewable energy in the region. The Energy Farm hopes to demonstrate how such an Energy Farm center in Ukraine could contribute to increased understanding about the use of renewable energy, energy efficiency and energy savings. With excursions to local entrepreneurs and meetings with local authorities.

Tuesday March 15th. Meetings with regional authorities in Hadeland and Oppland. Meetings with educational institutions and program leaders. Excursion to Bioenergy plants that deliver heat to small communities.

Wednesday March 16th. Practical demonstrations at the knowledge center Closing dialogue and discussion how to implement the project in Borshchiv and in nearby municipalities in Ukraine.
